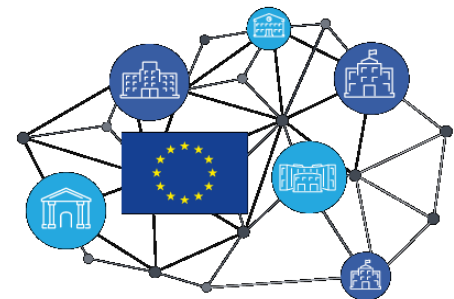
EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES: *objectives*

- Cooperation of Universities cross borders  networks of universities sharing the same vision and values, develop joint long-term institutional strategies for **top-quality education, research and innovation**.
- European Universities should drive the development of highly integrated and open study programmes combining modules in different countries. Mobility should be a standard feature, embedded at Bachelor, Master and Doctoral levels  contribution to **'European degrees' recognised throughout Europe**.

- Shared – long term strategy

- Transnational knowledge-creating teams
- Open up existing programmes (not new programmes)

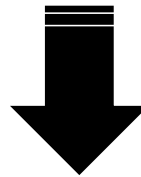

Possibility to reapply under the next MFF after a positive evaluation

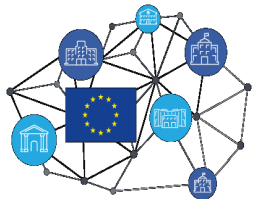
EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES CALL 2019 - Eligibility criteria

APPLICANT: HEIs in Programme Country with ECHE

ELIGIBLE ORGANISATIONS: HEIs with ECHE with affiliated entities (if any)

MINIMUM: 3 HEIs from 3 Member States or Programme Countries, in addition any other associated partner (public or private organisation)

QUALITY EVALUATION: 5 award criteria



Relevance of the project – max 25 points

Geographical balance – max 15 points

Quality of proposal and implementation – max 20 points

Quality of the alliance cooperation arrangements

- max 20 points

Sustainability and dissemination – max 20 points

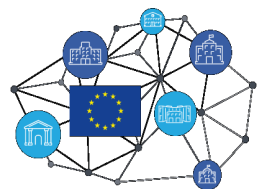
